Lydian's Amulsar Receives International Cyanide Management Code Certification

TORONTO, Feb. 06, 2018 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- <u>Lydian International Ltd.</u> (TSX:LYD) (“Lydian” or “the Company”) is pleased to announce that its Amulsar Gold Project has been pre-operationally certified in compliance with the International Cyanide Management Code (“Cyanide Code”). The announcement was made on January 18, 2018 by the International Cyanide Management Institute.

The Cyanide Code is a voluntary industry program designed to assist the global gold and silver mining industry and the producers and transporters of cyanide used in gold and silver mining in improving cyanide management practices. Amulsar is the fifth operation to become pre-operationally certified since the inception of the Cyanide Code and the first operation to receive pre-operational certification since amendments to the Cyanide Code were published in 2016. By receiving this pre-operational certification, Lydian is agreeing to be audited within one year of its first receipt of cyanide to evaluate Amulsar's operational compliance with the Cyanide Code. Follow-up audits will occur every three years thereafter.

Howard Stevenson, President and Chief Executive Officer of Lydian, said, "Pre-operational certification under the Cyanide Code is a significant achievement for Amulsar and reflects our Company's ongoing commitment to good international industry practices."

Lydian is a gold developer focusing on construction at its 100%-owned Amulsar Gold Project, located in south-central Armenia. Amulsar will be a large-scale, low-cost operation with production expected to begin in the third quarter of 2018. Open pit mining and conventional heap leach processing contribute to excellent scale and economic potential. Amulsar will be Armenia's largest gold mine and make Lydian one of the largest emerging gold producers of 2018. Estimated mineral resources contain 3.5 million measured and indicated gold ounces and 1.3 million inferred gold ounces. Gold production is targeted to average approximately 225,000 ounces annually over an initial 10-year mine life as outlined in the Q1 2017 Technical Report. Existing mineral resources beyond current reserves and open extensions provide opportunities to improve average annual production and extend the mine life.
