

Trade Winds to Speak at the Rodman & Renshaw Global Investment Conference: Al Gore, Dr. Henry Kissinger and Dick Cheney Will Keynote

As Operator, we published a February 2011 NI43-101 compliant resource estimate by Watts, Griffis and McQuat on the 50/50 Block A Joint Venture with Detour Gold Corporation, including an US\$1,000 in-pit indicated resource of 70.8 million tonnes grading 0.85 g/t gold containing 1.924 million ounces and an inferred resource of 27.3 million tonnes grading 0.87 g/t gold containing 762,000 ounces at a cutoff grade of 0.4 g/t.

Trade Winds Ventures Inc. has been named to the 2011 TSX Venture 50, a ranking of strong performing companies listed on TSX Venture Exchange.
